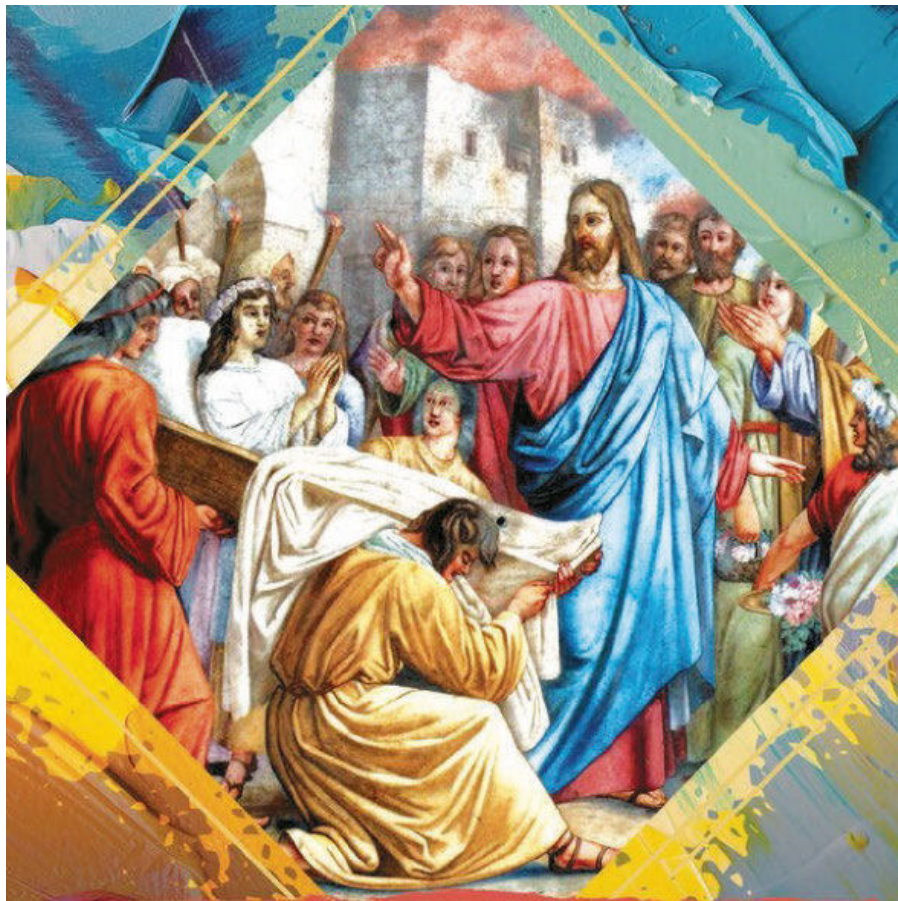

SACRAMENTS

BAPTISMS: Parents are the only ones authorized to register for the child's baptism. If parents are separated, we need a letter of permission from the separated parent. Registration and guidance is available, in the Church Office, two months in advance of administering the sacrament of Baptism. A copy of the child's birth certificate and \$50.00 for baptism registration. Baptisms are held the last Saturday of the month at 4:30 pm.

Parents and Godparents must be registered to St. Vincent. If they belong to another Church they must provide a letter from their Church.

WEDDING: Couples must make arrangements directly with a priest 6 months in advance. Please call **305-226-4664** to register for your marriage preparation classes.

MINISTRY OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish office **954-972-0434** to request sick calls for patients at home. If you are hospitalized and would like to be visited by the Chaplain, please inform the hospital of your Catholic affiliation. For the anointing of the sick please inform the office ahead of time.

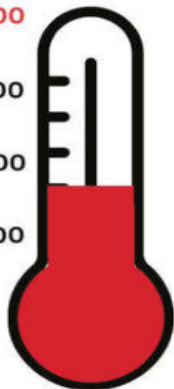

PARISH REGISTRATION



When you register in the parish, come to mass on Sundays and participate in parish activities, you are practicing your faith and are considered an active

parishioner. When you use the offertory envelopes or online giving, you are showing your commitment in supporting your parish, as well as creating a record of your active presence in the community. Registration is required for receiving any parish official document, such as eligibility certificates to be godparents, permits to celebrate sacraments in other churches, school verification for children, or any other letter for legal purposes. Registration for at least three months is required for the celebration of sacraments. Thank you for becoming a member of our community of St. Vincent in Margate.

GOSPEL MEDITATION

13th Sunday in Ordinary Time



Sin isn't given its due these days. Downplaying sin is dangerous. But there is also another spiritual misstep in which we make way too big a deal out of sin. It happens, for example, when we persistently wonder if our confessed sins are "really" forgiven, or suspiciously ponder what God "really" thinks about us, behind His merciful face. Or when someone returns to Church, and we question whether his or her conversion was genuine. Or when we commit some sin and put on a sad face for days, thinking, "Maybe my sins are too great for God to deal with." God save us from that attitude!

Well, he does just that, this week, in the raising of Jairus' daughter. The dead twelve-year-old's house is filled with a spirit of excessive moaning and groaning, tumultuous weeping and wailing. They even laugh at Jesus in a mocking tone. It's shocking how *easy* it is for him to raise the dead child. It is equivalent to gently waking a kid from a light nap. And then he sends her off to get some lunch. No big whoop. The overactive drama is actually part of the problem, and removing it is a key part of the miracle.

Friends, sin can and does kill, but Jesus is *always* ready and able to raise us back to life, often without much hullabaloo. His ease of forgiving should never be a pretext for presumption, minimizing sin, or taking lightly the cost he pays for our sins on the cross. But for God's sake, we often need Jesus to put out the weepers and wailers. He's the Lord. And remember, the girl is not dead, she's just sleeping.

VENERABLE ANTONIETTA MEO

SHORT BIO: Venerable Antonietta Meo, born in Rome, died of bone cancer at just 6 years old. In her short life she wrote hundreds of little letters to Jesus and Mary displaying a deep spiritual maturity and had a profound understanding of the redemptive value of suffering.



BIOGRAPHY: Venerable Antonietta Meo (1930-1937), affectionately nicknamed Nennolina by her family, was a child born in Rome. Her family was deeply Catholic and sent her to a nursery school run by Catholic sisters. As a very young child, she had an unnaturally deep understanding of Christ's love. When Antonietta was 6, she had a leg amputated due to bone cancer. From this moment on, she experienced varying degrees of chronic pain. Shortly after the amputation, while she was still in the hospital, her father asked her if she was in pain. Antonietta replied, "Daddy, the pain is like fabric, the stronger it is, the more value it has." All those who overheard were astounded.

From this moment, Antonietta frequently offered her pain and suffering to Jesus. Even at such a young age, her profound understanding of prayer and suffering was inspiring to everyone who knew her. She was fitted with a prosthetic leg and of her experience of it she said, "May each step that I take be a little word of love."

Impressed by her maturity and spiritual knowledge, her family priest recommended she receive her First Communion earlier than most children. She was ecstatic at the opportunity and received her First Communion on Christmas night of 1936. Afterward, she spent an hour kneeling in prayer. She took Confirmation only a few months later, however the amputation had not stopped the spread of the cancer and her health went downhill swiftly following these sacraments.

During the entirety of her short life, Antonietta wrote hundreds of letters to Jesus and Mary. Pope Pius IX, who had heard of them from a friend, was impressed and sent an emissary to her house to ask her to pray for him. After her death, she was declared Venerable, and her writings persist to this day at the Basilica of the Holy Cross of Jerusalem in Rome.

MENSAGEM

Tema do 13.º Domingo do Tempo Comum



Nascemos para viver, ou para morrer? Será a morte o objetivo ou a intenção última do projeto de Deus sobre o homem? A liturgia do 13.º Domingo comum procura responder a estas questões. Convida-nos a olhar para lá do nosso horizonte de criaturas finitas e a descobrir a Vida verdadeira e eterna que Deus quer oferecer a todos os seus filhos e filhas.

Na **primeira leitura**, um “sábio” de Israel ensina que Deus criou-nos para sermos eternos. É verdade que todas as criaturas passam pela morte biológica; mas essa morte não impede que cheguemos à Vida eterna. Só escolhas de egoísmo e de autossuficiência podem impedir-nos de encontrar essa Vida eterna que está no plano que Deus tem para nós.

O **Evangelho** mostra como Jesus cumpriu a missão que o Pai lhe confiou: dar-nos Vida. Ao curar uma mulher de uma hemorragia que a mantinha presa a uma vida sem horizontes, ou ao pegar pela mão uma jovem para a resgatar da morte, Jesus está a concretizar o plano de Deus e a salvar da morte os filhos e filhas que Deus tanto ama. Abraçamos essa Vida quando confiamos em Jesus, acolhemos as suas indicações, seguimo-lo no caminho que Ele nos aponta.

Na **segunda leitura** Paulo de Tarso, a propósito de uma questão concreta (o apoio a uma Igreja que passa por dificuldades materiais), convida-nos a encarar a vida a partir de um dinamismo de amor. Esse amor, é expressão da Vida de Deus; mas também é gerador de Vida, de Vida verdadeira.

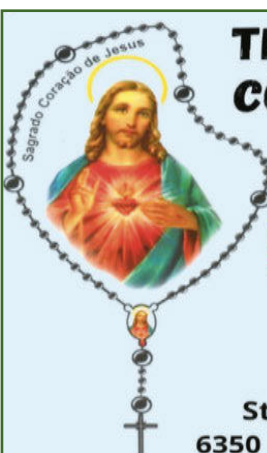
