SACRAMENTS

BAPTISMS: Parents are the only ones authorized to register for the child's baptism. If parents are separated, we need a letter of permission from the separated parent. Registration and guidance is available in the Church Office, two months in advance of administering the sacrament of Baptism. A copy of the child's birth certificate and \$50.00 for baptism registration. Baptisms are held on second Saturday of the month at 10:00 am. Parents and Godparents must be registered to St. Vincent for at least 6 months. If they belong to another Church they must provide a letter from their Church.

WEDDING: Couples must make arrangements directly with a priest 6 months in advance. Please call **305-226-4664** to register for your marriage preparation classes.

MINISTRY OF THE SICK: Please call the Parish office **954-972-0434** to request sick calls for patients at home. If you are hospitalized and would like to be visited by the Chaplain, please inform the hospital of your Catholic affiliation. For the anointing of the sick please inform the office ahead of time.

CATECHISM 101

THE INTERIOR OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH



Each of the objects, the surroundings in our Catholic churches, has a purpose and a history. May we always seek the mysteries, beauty and love of Christ found in our sacred place.

The Tabernacle



Since there were no churches during those early centuries, Christians did not have a tabernacle as we do today. However they were careful to protect the Blessed Sacrament. There is some evidence that following their divine services, Christians took the consecrated bread home and consumed it during the week. By the fourth century, when construction of churches began, any reserved hosts were kept in various rooms in the church, including an area that became known as the sacristy. Theft, pilferage or worse was a serious threat, especially following the Protestant Reformation, when violence was carried out against the Catholic Church.

The design of the tabernacle slowly evolved, and by the 16th century tabernacles similar to those we have today were in use. Canon Law spells out the rules for the tabernacle's location: "The tabernacle in which the Blessed Eucharist is reserved should be sited in a distinguished place in the church or oratory, a place which is conspicuous, suitably adorned and conducive to prayer" (No. 938.2). As authorized by Church law, and approved by the local bishop, some churches use a separate chapel to house the tabernacle. The tendency today is to keep the tabernacle in proximity to the altar.

Wherever located, the tabernacle is always locked and immovable in order to protect the Eucharist.

Sanctuary Lamp



In every Catholic Church we find a readily visible lamp or candle burning before the tabernacle. This is the same light the Magi followed until they found the baby Jesus in a stable. This ever-present light still beckons to each of us. We all look for the flickering flame as soon as we enter the church. Our attitude and demeanor change as we recognize that we are in the house of the living God. The flame signifies his presence and a sign that our love for the Lord is eternal, never to be extinguished. (See Canon Law 940) The flame of the tabernacle lamp is purposely transferred from candle to candle beginning with the fire lit at the Easter Vigil Mass.

Did you know there are churches in Rome older than St. Peter's? St. John Lateran is one of four major basilicas in the Eternal City, and it

is by far the oldest. The land was donated by an ancient Roman family to the Emperor Constantine, who in turn gave it to the Church. For hundreds of years, St. John Lateran was the "mother church." Popes lived on the grounds through the 14th century. The church itself suffered from pillaging by invaders, fires, and earthquakes. It has been restored and rebuilt five times since the 300s. On this feast, we remember more than a building. We celebrate the resiliency of our faith. Though trials may come in our parishes, personal lives, and the world, the Church endures through the grace of Jesus Christ.

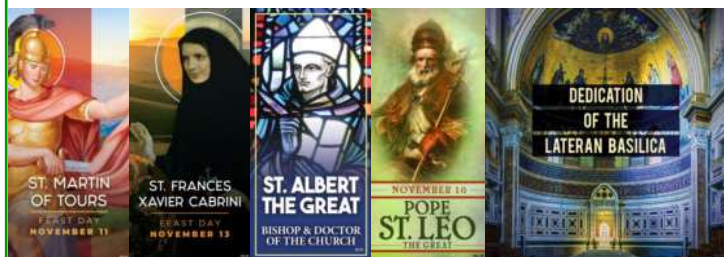

GOSPEL MEDITATION

The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica



When I was 22, I entered St. Peter's Basilica for the first time. It floored me. I could hardly take it in, its grandeur, majestic arches, vibrant colors, and the light that danced through its high windows. Somehow, amidst such splendor, I felt an overwhelming sense of belonging, as if I had finally come home.

Jesus reorients how we Catholics see sacred buildings. In today's Gospel he says, **"Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up"** (John 2:13-22). His riddle implies, shockingly, that his own body is now the fundamental dwelling place of God and humanity. The temple in Jerusalem has been superseded.

In our churches today - whether they mirror the basilica's grandeur or embrace humble simplicity - we experience architectural symbols of Christ's risen body. It is no accident we call them "churches": they make visible in brick-and mortar Christ's body which is made up of the living stones we call Christians. Each church building, like St. John Lateran in Rome, or St. Peter's, or any other, is meant to be a vibrant sign of Christ's resurrected body. We should cherish and protect our churches as places where heaven touches earth, where we, as a community, are raised to the fullness of life in Christ.

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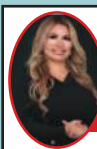
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
